



Spring has come early so why not join us this **Friday, 11th September** for a leisurely trip to **Bowral** to admire the tulips. This is such an easy trip; only one train, lifts to and from the platforms and no hills. The tulips in Corbett Park and Apex Park will be at their best. We don't book admission to Corbett Gardens but you can pay entry on the day if you wish to. Catching the 8.44am train from Campbelltown (Platform 4) or 8.47am from Macarthur, we will arrive just in time for morning tea, then the day is yours to explore. We will leave Bowral station on the 1.07pm or 2.07pm train, arriving back in Campbelltown at 2.20pm or 3.20pm respectively. Just be mindful to avoid the Quiet carriage on these trains.

The OCTOBER OUTING will be on Friday, 16th October when we will travel to **Brighton-Le-Sands** by train and bus to see the First Fleet Memorial in Cook Park along the Grand Parade adjacent to Botany Bay. We will certainly see a lot of planes arriving and departing Mascot Airport. We will leave on the 9.14am train from Leumeah (9.08am Macarthur), (carriage 4) and alight at Wolli Creek to catch the 10.08am service to Rockdale where we can have morning tea before catching the bus down Bay Street to the Grand Parade. There are numerous cafes on this strip, also an RSL or you may prefer to take your own lunch and just enjoy the view across the bay from the foreshore pathway.

On **FRIDAY 13TH NOVEMBER** the TWO50 outing will be to the newly opened **POWERHOUSE MUSEUM IN PARRAMATTA**. Entry is free except for one exhibition. We will travel by train to Parramatta so the whole day can be spent in this new venue. More details in next month's Pro Buzz.
