Monday 4th August 2025 - A day in the wild, Bargo.

This is a tour of the Australian wildlife sanctuary at 3105 Remembrance Driveway, Bargo (Old Hume Highway). You can even get up close with a koala for a photo. After the tour we will drive back to Tahmoor for lunch at Tahmoor Inn.

Rendezvous time & travel mode	Meet at Camden Showground Carpark, off Cawdor Road, next to the Crown Hotel, for a 9.45am start
Walking distance	About 6kms
Estimated time	2+ hours + morning tea and lunch
Grade	Medium. A relatively flat walk on gravel and sealed paths. There is a slow incline towards the end as we re-enter the local streets of Camden. Covered shoes with good grip are essential.
Transport	Your own vehicle.
Coffee/Lunch	Coffee at Camden, plenty of options. Lunch at venues along Argyle Street - your choice
IMPORTANT	As we walk for several hours, you need to be reasonably fit and able to maintain a steady walking pace. To avoid dehydration, make sure you have a hat, plus carry and consume sufficient water.
